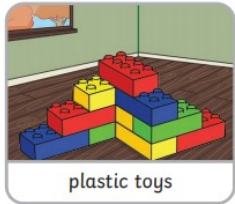


Objects are things.

Water is clear.

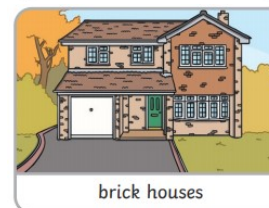


Rock can be rough or smooth.
